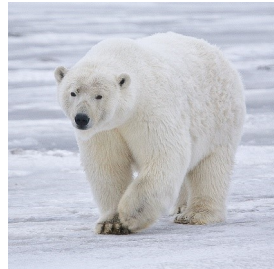


How Animals Cope with COLD weather

Fur / feathers change to white in the winter time



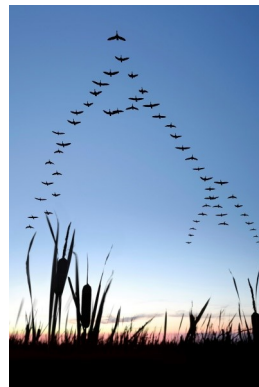
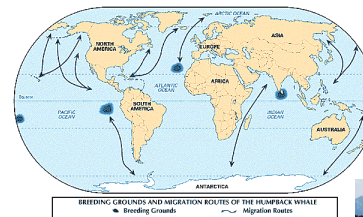
Fur / feathers changes to brown in the summer time

Camels have long eyelashes and can close their nostrils to protect them from blowing sand.

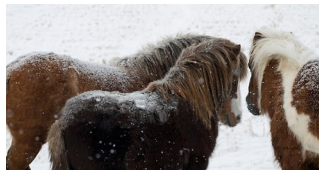


Big ears help fennec foxes cool off
